I-short- haired breeds:

British short-haired



✓ The head is wide between a comparatively small ears with short nose and well developed cheeks.

The coat is short, fine and close.

A variety of colours as blacks, blues, whites with blue or orange eyes a black and red patches present on white.

Brown colour with black marking also present.

Siamese cats



- This is the most popular of the foreign type breeds. The head is long and wedge shaped with large ears which are wide at the base.
- The eyes are deep blue and are almond in shape, standing towards the nose.
- The body is long and the legs are slim, the hind legs being slightly larger than the front ones.
- The body colour is ivory, with mask, ears, legs and tail of a contrasting colour the most common colour is a seal brown, know as seal, blue, chocolate and red colours are present.
- All Siamese kitten are born pure white, their coats darken as they grow.



II Long- haired breeds:

Persians



- The head has a wide skull, a short nose, a broad muzzle and small ears.
- The body is massive and the legs and the tail are short & thick.
- The coat is long and flowing, fine in texture and standing out from the body, with a large ruff continuing in a deep frill between the front legs. It has various colours, black blue, cream, white with blue or orange eyes.
